



Other Scholarships for IT&CS Students

With the assistance of the Lakeland Foundation and family and friends of the IT&CS department and the community at large, we are pleased to announce two scholarships specifically for IT&CS students

Judith A. Mazzeo Memorial Endowed Scholarship (*Newly established and/or growing endowment funds that will have funding available in subsequent years*)

The Judith A. Mazzeo Memorial Endowed Scholarship Fund was established in memory of Judith A. Mazzeo by her family. Judy Mazzeo was a full-time professor in the Information Technology and Computer Science Department from 1982 until her death in 2010.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be full-time or part-time students of Lakeland Community College enrolled in the Information Technology or Computer Science programs with the intent to pursue a bachelor's degree in a related field.
- Preference will be given to qualified female students.
- Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25 after their first semester of enrollment.

Richard Tomchak Memorial Endowed Scholarship

The scholarship is meant to memorialize one of Lakeland Community College's "charter" and most beloved instructors. The Fund will be used to provide scholarship assistance to Lakeland students with any academic major or career aspiration, although preference will be given to students in information technology and related areas.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Recipients must be full-time or part-time students of Lakeland Community College.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 after their first semester of enrollment.
- Recipients may be enrolled in any academic area or have career aspirations in any area although preference will be given to students enrolled in information technology or related academic areas.
