Students who wish to enter the surgical technology program must meet the criteria of one of the following three options. Applicants who have completed all the requirements for admission will be accepted on a space-available basis. If completion of the criteria occurs after the incoming class is filled, students will be admitted into the next available class.

PLEASE CHECK THE APPROPRIATE ADMISSIONS OPTION:

OPTION 1: HIGH SCHOOL OPTION (or a current College Credit Plus (CCP) student)

Student should submit this form at the time of application to Lakeland Community College. This option is for current high school seniors and high school graduates who apply to the program within two (2) years of high school graduation. Student must have all of the following:

- A. An overall high school GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale)
- B. Meets or exceeds Ohio's college readiness standards prior to their initial enrollment into Lakeland (Place into college-level Math & English. See Counseling and Advising Center for additional information.)
- C. Completed high school biology and chemistry in the past five years; OR successful completion of BIOL1200 or CHEM 1100; OR a passing score on biology placement test/CLEP test
- D. Attend the Health Information Session offered by the Counseling and Advising Center
- E. An official copy of your high school transcript at the time of application and again, once graduated, if still in high school.

Students admitted into the High School Option need to complete the following courses in their first semester (exceptions with permission of ST program director

- BIOL 2210 Anatomy and Physiology I *
- HLTH 1215 Medical Terminology*
- FYEX 1000 First Year Experience

The above courses need to be completed with a "C" grade or higher.

*BIOL2210 and HLTH1215 must have a combined GPA of 2.50 or higher. Students must also have an overall cumulative GPA of 2.0 higher while enrolled in the ST program.

OPTION 2: COLLEGE OPTION

The College Option is for students who do not qualify for admission under the High School Option, may have some college credits or those who prefer a part-time program. Please note that students must complete the surgical technology courses in the required sequence and time frame.

Admission Requirements:

- A. Successful completion of any required developmental courses based on college readiness standards (Place into college-level Math & English. See Counseling and Advising Center for additional information)
- B. Attend the Health Information Session offered by the Counseling and Advising Center
- C. Completed high school biology and chemistry in the past five years; OR successful completion or transfer credits of BIOL1200 or CHEM 1100; OR a passing score on biology placement test/CLEP test
- D. An official copy of your high school transcript with the graduation date on it or a copy of your General Educational Development (GED). (Must be submitted to the Student Service Center) Verified with SSC (Y/N): _____
- E. If you are transferring any college credits, please send an official copy of all college transcripts, and meet with Counseling for a Transcript Review.
- F. Complete the following prerequisite courses* (or equivalent courses from a regionally accredited college) prior to applying for admission into the ST program:

- BIOL 2210 Anatomy and Physiology I grade: _____
- HLTH 1215 Medical Terminology grade: _____

*The above courses need to be completed with a "C" grade or higher. BIOL2210 and HLTH1215 must have a combined GPA of 2.50 or higher. Students must also have an overall cumulative GPA of 2.0 higher while enrolled in the ST program.
