ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Prospective students must meet the Ursuline College Accelerated Program (UCAP) admission standards for transfer students. We require the completion of an online application at www.ursuline.edu/apply and an associate degree from a CoARC-accredited school of Respiratory Therapy with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, active credential as an RRT, resume highlighting current practice in the field of respiratory care, one letter of recommendation from an academic or health care professional and submission of all transcripts from previous colleges. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable, with official transcripts required within your first semester of classes.

PARALLEL PROGRAM:

A completed Associate of Applied Science in Respiratory Therapy from a CoARC-accredited school is required.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Once the online application and all previous college transcripts are received, the applicant will be evaluated for acceptance into the UCAP/ Holden University Partnership program. A follow-up meeting will be scheduled to review your unofficial degree plan, course options and if ready to move forward, proceed with course registration.
