## Steps to follow to enter into the EMT Basic class

- 1. Register as a student at Lakeland if you have not done so already
- 2 You must have a current CPR card (either one of these will do):
  - a. American Heart Healthcare Provider
  - b. Red Cross Professional Rescuer
- You are required to complete a criminal background check prior to attending clinicals. We use Corporate Screening, 16530 Commerce Court, Cleveland, OH 44130-6305, 1.800.229.8606. The cost of the background check (\$68.00) will be billed to your tuition bill from Lakeland. Based on the results of the background check, you may not be able to attend clinicals.
- 4 You also must have on file a current health form with the EMT/Paramedic office. The TB test is only good for 12 months (TB test may need to be repeated).
- 5. You must complete all the forms provided to you the first night of class by the fourth week of class.
- 6. Must complete ICS-100 and ICS-700.
- 7. The EMT basic class, EMTS 1010, is offered both Fall and Spring semesters as listed below:

Day class 830 am-1215pm Tuesday and Thursday Night class 630 pm-1030pm Monday and Wednesday Night class 630pm-1030pm Tuesday and Thursday

If you do not complete all of the above steps, you will not be allowed to attend the clinical portion of the class. These steps should be completed as early as possible. If you don't complete the clinical portion of the class, you will not be allowed to sit for the National Registry and you may receive a failing grade for the course.
