



The Cleveland State University (CSU) Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) program allows students to earn a bachelor's degree in general business administration from CSU's Monte Ahuja College of Business. Ideal for working adults, this program affords students the opportunity to acquire a comprehensive foundation of business knowledge combined with advanced exposure to multiple areas of business.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Students must meet the CSU admission standards for transfer students, including a 2.0 cumulative grade-point average (GPA) from Lakeland Community College and any additional colleges or universities attended. PARALLEL LAKELAND PROGRAMS:

An Associates of Arts or Associate of Applied Business degree will assist students in completing corresponding coursework needed for the BBA including both general education requirements and lower-division business pre-requisites. A completed associate's is not required, but highly encouraged.

TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

The BBA requires a minimum of 120 total credit hours. A minimum of 30 credit hours must be CSU coursework.
