

Lakeland students may qualify for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits!

Per the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 (a federal law), students who were previously excluded from the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) may be eligible on a temporary basis if they meet the following criteria:

- Enrolled in at least 6 credit hours (at least half time) for the current semester at Lakeland Community College;
- Have an "Estimated Family Contribution" (EFC) of 0 as determined by the current aid year's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA); and/or
- Currently eligible to participate in the Federal Work-Study program (as determined by the Financial Aid Office).
