

The Bowling Green State University (BGSU) Bachelor of Science in Technology majoring in Quality Systems (QS) program emphasizes quality principles designed to provide professional preparation for emerging leaders in change and improvement. Courses are taught by world-class faculty with industry experience and widely-published authors that are leaders in their field. Graduates of the quality systems online degree completion program are qualified for high demand, high paying positions in major industries including manufacturing, health care, government, military, education, service operations, retail, engineering, banking, finance and construction.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Students must have an applied associate's degree from a regionally accredited institution, be close to completing one or currently in a quality-related field with some previous college coursework. TUITION & FEES:

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Students request registration through the eCampus office after admission to BGSU. Students receive one-stop-shop services through BGSU's eCampus office, assisting students from application to graduation.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

Courses are offered in seven-week sessions throughout the year. Students can begin the program in August, October, January, March, May and June.

DELIVERY MODE:

The program is offered 100 percent online. There is never a need to visit campus. Many students come to campus for the first time to attend graduation.

TEXTBOOK PURCHASE:

Information is available upon admission to BGSU.

PARALLEL LAKELAND PROGRAMS:

Students with associate degrees in science, technology, engineering or math can apply hours toward the BGSU QS program. Other subject areas may be applicable with QS work experience. BGSU eCampus personnel can assist if you have questions regarding eligibility.

TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

QS requires 124 semester hours. The exact hours to complete the program vary depending on each individual's transfer hours and courses taken.

FINANCIAL AID INFO:
