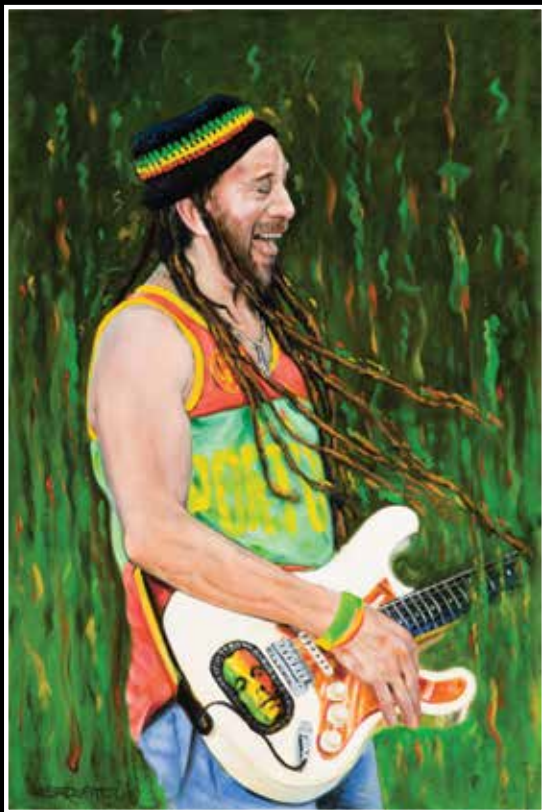

**Jae Jarrell** American Postwar & Contemporary artist. Studied at Bowling Green State University, and Art and Fashion Design: The School of the Art Institute of Chicago. BFA from Howard University, Washington, DC, Magna Cum Laude (Dean's list). Graduate school at Howard University, and at Parson-the New School in New York City, where she studied textile design.

Jae received an Honorary Doctorate Degree from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago during Commencement in 2020.

Jae became a founding member of AfriCOBRA, the African Commune of Bad Relevant Artists (the African American artist collective that sought to invoke the styles of African art while infusing a strong call for revolution), sculpting and painting classic revolutionary garb.

Her works are in many private and Museum collections including, Brooklyn Museum, Smart Museum, and the Rennie Collection. Vancouver, Canada. Exhibitions include, The First Biennial Toronto, Canada, 2019, AFRICOBRA: Nation Time, Venice Biennale, Venice, Italy, 2019

Jae Jarrell is known for social themed fashion design, fabric art, sculpture, furniture building.

It was great to hear the news from Mary Urbas, coordinator of the Gallery at Lakeland College, that it was time for my service to jury the pristine expressions of art in all it's diversity.
