 Full payment is due at time of registration and includes a \$100 processing fee that is nonrefundable after May 1, 2018.

• A payment plan is available for registrations made prior to April 2, 2018 for the full eight-week session only. Fifty percent of the fee is due with registration. The balance must be paid in full by the end the of the business day, Friday, May 18, 2018. The deadline for registering for the full eight-weeks is June 4, 2018.

Musical Theater and Production Camp

Go behind the scenes and be part of a theater production from start to finish! Each day will be packed with exercises in acting, improvisation, set painting, prop making, musicals and much more. The three-week camp will conclude with an onstage production Friday, July 6, 2018. Register early, enrollment is limited.

Participants do not need previous acting or musical experience. However, this camp is designed for children with an interest in theater and acting. Campers should bring a lunch, or money to purchase one in Lakeland's dining hall. One daily snack is provided. Drop-off is 7:30-9 a.m. and pick up is 4-6 p.m. at the athletic and fitness center and is included in the fee. Cellphones, headphones and other electronic devices, are prohibited during camp activities including sign-in and sign-out.
