

Earn credits for college classes based on your experience!

Are you interested in earning a degree in Information Technology? Have you previously worked in the IT field? The Opportunities in Tech grant program allows students to earn college credit for prior learning by demonstrating mastery of course outcomes—skills and knowledge—through Credit-By-Exam.

Here are the requirements and guidelines:

- Students must be enrolled in the SCC3 Equity in Tech Grant program (We will accept students for the duration of the grant). Scan the QR code below to register!
- Obtain a "Request for Credit/Waiver for Courses" form from the Admissions Office and fill out the student information section. Afterward, take the completed form to the Cashier's Office to pay 50% of the Lake County Tuition cost for the course. Submit the form and a copy of your receipt to the IT&CS Credit by Examination Coordinator, Dr. Jennifer Crissman (jcrissman@lakelandcc.edu).
- Students will receive course outlines and have the option to purchase textbooks. Study at your own pace in preparation for the credit-by-exam test.
- The exam will be administered in the Testing Center during regular hours in the Fall and Spring semester. A minimum score of 80% is required to earn credit. If you pass with an 80% exam score, the grant will reimburse you 50% of the tuition you paid for the course.
- Students must provide proof of taking the exam and the test results. Contact Beth Cueni to process the refund at bcueni1@lakelandcc.edu.
- Credit by exam is available for all 1000-level IT&CS courses and certain 2000-level courses. Contact Dr. Crissman for information about specific courses.
