

# STATUS OF COLLEGE OPERATIONS



Lakeland is closely monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic, with protecting the health and well-being of our students, employees and campus community as our top priority. Lakeland's Smart, Safe, Strong Task Force is coordinating our gradual and safe transition to on-campus instruction and college operations.

## Academics

Lakeland plans to offer in-person classes this fall, along with a variety of remote and hybrid options. The fall semester will begin Aug. 22, but in-person classes will end Nov. 25, with the remainder of the semester's instruction - including final exams - being delivered remotely when classes resume after Thanksgiving break on Nov. 30.

## Current Hours of Operation

For the fall semester, most college departments will continue having increased hours of operation Mondays through Thursdays, when the majority of our students are taking courses and may need assistance (virtual or in-person), and will close Fridays at noon to allow more time for deep cleaning. ## Campus Entrances and Temperature Checks

All employees, students and visitors coming on campus must wear a mask and undergo a fast, contactless temperature check at the building entrances. A Lakeland team member will be there to assist you. Keep your mask on and follow social distancing signs. A thermal scan tablet will take your skin (forehead) temperature and confirm that you are wearing a mask.

If your temperature is greater than 100.4 degrees, you will be asked to leave campus and be provided with additional information. To protect your privacy, the college will not keep a record of temperature check results or share them with others.

To effectively manage this safety measure, only specific entrances will be open. See this [map](#) of available entrances. Please note that no doors will be open from the courtyard.
