A quick entry into health care.

Phlebotomy provides a quick-entry into the health care field. No degree required.

Phlebotomy technicians:

- » Collect blood sample from patients by venipuncture and skin puncture
- » Ensure quality samples to assure accurate lab results to perform diagnostic testing
- » Conform to CDC and OSHA guidelines
- » Communicate effectively with patients, lab personnel and other healthcare professionals

How long does it take to complete this program and be job-ready?

- » 16 credits (2 semesters)
- » Sessions start twice each spring and fall. Summer session also offered.



Credential

Lakeland's program graduates are eligible to take the national exam to become a certified phlebotomy technician, known as a PBT.
