



Scholarships available for Information Technology & Computer Science (IT&CS) Students

A variety of state-funded and Lakeland scholarships are available to students pursuing IT&CS degree and certificate programs at Lakeland.

Lakeland Foundation Scholarships

To apply for any of the scholarships listed below, complete the Lakeland Foundation Scholarship application, which can be found on myLakeland in the "Scholarship Center," located under "myRECORDS."

Gary Gust Spiros Memorial Scholarship

- All Lakeland IT&CS certificate and degree programs are eligible.
- Funds are available for tuition, fees, textbooks and educational supplies.
- Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA and have completed 12 credit hours of course work.
- Preference is given to first-generation college students or adult students entering college after being out of high school for more than five years.

Judith A. Mazzeo Memorial Endowed Scholarship

- All Lakeland IT&CS certificate and degree programs are eligible with the intent to pursue a bachelor's degree in a related field.
- Funds are available for tuition, fees, textbooks and educational supplies.
- Students must maintain a minimum cumulative 3.25 GPA.
- Preference is given to female students.

LaMantia Family Endowed Scholarship (Available for the 2023-2024 academic year)

- Computer science and STEM technology degrees are eligible.
- Funds are available for tuition, fees, textbooks and educational supplies.
- Preference is given to a student of Italian heritage, with ancestors having immigrated to the U.S. from Italy.

Lubrizol Foundation Tuition Scholarship

- Any computer science degree is eligible.
- Funds are available for tuition and fees; \$500/student.
- Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Students must have completed one semester of college.

Lubrizol Foundation Book Scholarship

- Any computer science degree is eligible.
- Funds are available for textbooks; \$100/student.
- Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- Students must have completed one semester of college.

Richard Tomchak Memorial Endowed Scholarship

- Any information technology or related degree is eligible.
- Funds are available for tuition, fees, textbooks and educational supplies.
- Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA.

State of Ohio Funded Programs

Choose Ohio First Scholarship

- All Lakeland IT&CS certificate and degree programs are eligible.
- Funds are available for tuition, general fees and textbooks.
- Applicant must be new to the eligible program or a new Lakeland student.
- Continuing students new to the eligible program must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Students must be an Ohio resident.
- To apply, complete the Lakeland Foundation Scholarship application, which can be found on myLakeland in the "Scholarship Center," located under "myRECORDS."

Ohio Short-term Certificate Grant

- Select Lakeland IT specialist certificate programs are eligible.
- Up to \$2,000 per eligible short-term certificate is available to cover tuition and fees for required classes only.
- Students can earn up to three different eligible short-term certificates (student must successfully complete one short-term certificate before receiving an award for another short-term certificate).
- Students must be an Ohio resident.
