Mandatory Student Health Requirements

The following mandatory student health requirements must be met prior to enrollment in the EMT and/or Paramedic programs. Clinical facilities require documentation of health requirements prior to participation in clinical experiences. Please schedule an appointment with your health care provider now. Your enrollment in a Health Technology Program will be delayed if these requirements are not met. All of the following requirements must be documented on the Student Health Record Form provided to you by Lakeland. Submit forms to:

Drop boxes are located: H-Building, ground floor by back door of dental hygiene,
and also 1st & 2nd floor near the water fountains.

Physical examination: A physical examination by a primary health care provider is required. This examination must be completed within one year prior to enrollment in the program.

Tuberculin Test: A two-step TB test or a QuantiFERON gold blood test is required prior to starting the program. Please note: Mantoux test results cannot be self-read, but must be read by a health official within 48-72 hours. This is a two-step process that takes nine days to complete. An official document listing date of administration and date of results must be submitted to the Health Services Department, in H-273, for each Mantoux test completed and a copy of the lab results for the blood test. After the initial two step or blood test an annual one step TB or blood work must be submitted prior to the current TB expiring. If the current one expires then you must have the two step TB or blood work done.

QuantiFERON gold blood test - Required within six months prior to starting clinicals for students who are known **positive reactors**.

Immunizations: The following immunizations **and/or** titers are required.

Hepatitis B: A series of three injections **or** a positive titer **or** you **must sign** a declination form. If the titer is negative, additional vaccinations are required or you **must sign** a declination form. The declination form is available in Health Services.

Mumps: A positive antibody titer. If your titer is **not** positive then you **must** receive a booster and re-titer 4-8 weeks later.

Rubella: A positive antibody titer. If your titer is **not** positive then you **must** receive a booster and re-titer 4-8 weeks later.

Rubeola: A positive antibody titer. If your titer is **not** positive then you **must** receive a booster and re-titer 4-8 weeks later.

Varicella: A positive antibody titer. If your titer is **not** positive then you **must** receive a booster and re-titer 4-8 weeks later.

Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis): Tdap should replace a single dose of Td for adults aged <65 years who have not previously received a dose of Tdap. This vaccine is good for 10 years.

Annual flu vaccine is required, it **must** be by injection not the intranasal vaccine.

Do not write "had disease" for any of the above.

You must also provide proof of (copy of cards): medical insurance
: CPR American Heart Association –BLS for Healthcare Provider
(2 year certification)

Recommended, but not required: Polio: A positive antibody titer.

Additional Requirements: You will receive information on required Background Check and drug screening separately. There are specific companies and procedures required by clinical sites, **do not** have these done until you receive the information from Lakeland to do so. Contact Health Services **as soon as you are accepted** into a program to get the Background/Drug screen information packet.
