## CONDUCTOR



**FRANK T. COSENZA** retired from the West Geauga Local Schools where he was a 4-time recipient of the Excellence in Education Award. He then served as Interim Director of Athletic Bands/Concert Band at Kent State University.

His groups have performed at Severance Hall for the Northeast Ohio Wind Band Invitational, the Ohio Music Education Association State Conference, the American School Band Directors Association State Conference, Ohio School Boards Association Conference and at Lincoln Center in New York City. Additionally, his groups have performed at the University of Akron Band Clinic, Hiram College,

Cleveland Browns halftime, the Cleveland Guardians (formerly the Cleveland Indians) as well as prestigious venues in Florida, Michigan, Georgia, and Canada.

Concert bands under his direction have received consistent superior ratings at Ohio Music Education Association (OMEA) adjudicated events. He has served on the Content Validation Panel for the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards and has been on the staff of American Music Abroad taking musicians to Europe. Additionally, he served as assistant director of the All-Ohio State Fair Band. Mr. Cosenza is an elected member of Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity, the American School Band Director's Association and Tau Beta Sigma.

As a member of OMEA, he has served as State Treasurer/trustee, District President, All-State co-coordinator, adjudicated events chair and current adjudicator, as well as being a member of music selection committees. He was the recipient of the Distinguished Service Award for OMEA District VII and was chosen as the "Honored Teacher" at West Geauga High School. He has served as guest conductor and clinician in Florida, Kansas, Nevada and throughout Ohio as well as an adjudicator for "Music In The Parks/Festivals of Music."

He has been the summer conductor of the Lakeland Community College Civic Band since 2018 and has conducted concerts for the Cleveland Federation of Musicians, the Windjammers Unlimited (Circus Music Historical Society) and the W. D. Packard Concert Band. He was formerly associate conductor of the Medina Community Band. Mr. Cosenza is Co-Principal Trumpet with the W.D. Packard Concert Band of Warren and has played for many shows and artists including Frankie Avalon, The Manhattan Transfer, Wayne Newton, Johnny Mathis, Holiday On Ice, the Ringling Bros. Barnum & Bailey Circus and Ludwig Masters recordings. He is a Conn-Selmer endorsing artist and received a Bachelor of Music from Bowling Green State University and Master of Music from The University of Akron, where he received the Distinguished Music Educator Alumni Award in 2020.

## CLARINETIST

**BRUCE LANGGUTH**, clarinetist, has been performing in the northern Ohio area for over 40 years with a variety of ensembles, including concert bands, symphony orchestras and chamber music groups. His professional career began in Toluca, Mexico, performing as a symphonic clarinetist with the State of Mexico Symphony Orchestra. He then accepted a position in the Mexico City Philharmonic, where he continued playing concerts throughout Mexico.

His formal training consists of a Bachelor of Music degree from Baldwin Wallace University, followed by a Master of Music degree from the University of Michigan, where his principal clarinet teacher was David Shifrin, former principal clarinetist with the Cleveland Orchestra.

Langguth has been a member of the clarinet sections of concert bands throughout Ohio, including the Blossom Festival Concert Band, the Sounds of Sousa Concert Band, the W.D. Packard Concert Band, the Akron Symphonic Winds, Cleveland Federation of Musicians Band and The Hillcrest Concert Band. He is now in his sixth season with the Lakeland Civic Band.

In addition, Langguth performs for special events, church services and celebrations throughout Northeast Ohio. He has taught clarinet lessons to aspiring musicians for many years, and currently teaches private lessons at Pfabe's Music in Painesville, Ohio.

## Lakeland Civic Band

**THE LAKELAND CIVIC BAND** was founded by Mr. Charles Frank in 1977 with the purpose of providing an opportunity for instrumentalists from the area to perform band literature of the highest quality. Its membership is drawn from Lakeland students, talented high school players, school music teachers and directors, and community musicians who are selected by audition. In addition to hosting guest artists and conductors, the band features several of its members as soloists or conductors each season. The band's 20th Anniversary featured the world renowned Dr. Frederick Fennell as guest conductor; the 25th Anniversary featured Col. John Bourgeois, former conductor of the U.S. Marine Band; the 30th Anniversary featured Loras John Schissel, renowned conductor of the Blossom Festival Band; and the 35th Anniversary featured Col. Timothy Foley, also former conductor of the U.S. Marine Band.

During its history, the Lakeland Civic Band has commissioned three original compositions including "Poem for Band" by Dr. Rex Mitchell, formerly of Clarion State University in Pennsylvania; "Ode to a Clocktower" composed in honor of the band's 25th Anniversary by former Lakeland faculty member, Dan Rager, and "Suite: The American West" by Lakeland faculty member, Stephen Stanziano. In addition to its regular schedule of concerts held at Lakeland each year, the band has performed at Mentor High School, Perry High School, Wickliffe High School, Lakeside High School, Kirtland Middle School, Cleveland State University, Cuyahoga Community College Western Campus, the Kent State University Stark Campus, and Severance Hall.

The Lakeland Civic Band has been honored by invitations to perform for national, state and regional conferences including the Ohio Music Education Association Conferences in 1980, 1985, 1991, 2003 and 2006; the North Central Regional Conference of the College Band Directors National Association at The Ohio State University in 1982; the National Convention of the American School Band Directors Association in Columbus, Ohio in 1993; and the National Convention of the Association of Concert Bands in Lisle, Illinois in 1998. The civic band and chorus were invited to perform at the Chautauqua Institute in 1997, 1999 and 2002. In 1997, the Lakeland Civic Band received the Sudler Silver Scroll Award presented by the Sousa Foundation in recognition of musical excellence and service to the community. The Lakeland Civic Band is one of the few community college groups that have received this award based on an evaluation of continued musical achievements and performance tapes.
