Steps to Transfer Your Credits

Step 2: Seniors Complete Your Articulation Agreement

➤ Signed by you, your teacher, and Lakeland's Tech Prep Coordinator, the Articulation Agreement confirms that you have completed your high school program and are entitled to credit.

Make Sure Your Credits Transfer!

Steps to Transfer Your Credits

Step 3: <u>Ask your counselor</u> to send your final transcript to the <u>Lakeland's Tech</u> <u>Prep Office!</u>



Students may not submit transcripts.



Tech Prep does not have access to Naviance or other college application programs.



Transcripts submitted to the Admissions Office are not shared with the Tech Prep office!

Make Sure Your Credits Transfer!

FAQs

1. What if I am not going to Lakeland? Will I still get credit?

Acceptance of credit is only guaranteed at Lakeland. Other institutions are sent your credit, but make an independent determination on whether to accept your credit.

2. What do I do if I am going to another college but I want credit?

Take all the steps outlined in this presentation. Your credits need to be "parked" somewhere before they can be transferred to another institution. By taking these steps, we are able to create a Lakeland transcript that can be sent to another institution.

3. Are my credits automatically sent to the college I am going to?

No. Lakeland has no way of knowing what school any individual student plans to attend. You will need to fill out a Request for Transcript of Record Form so that we can send your transcript to the school.

4. How many credits am I entitled to?

The number of credits an individual student qualifies for depends on a variety of factors including high school performance, the program the student decides to pursue, and whether the student attends Lakeland.
