

Learning design, often referred to as instructional design, is an emerging field that focuses on how to use new media and instructional technologies to create environments and programs that enhance teaching and learning. The Bowling Green State University (BGSU) Master of Education in Learning Design provides individuals with the technical and organizational skills for creating and delivering education and training in a range of settings such as the traditional classroom, online and blended environments. For reasons of speed, cost and efficiency organizations are shifting to electronic platforms for upgrading the knowledge, skills and competencies of its employees through online and blended programs.

**ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:**

Applicants are required to submit scanned copies of official or unofficial transcripts from all institutions attended. Upon admission, final official or notarized copies of transcripts from all institutions where degrees were earned and diplomas from international institutions must be submitted. GRE test scores (within the last five years) are required for those applying for the Master of Education program that have not already earned a master's degree. Three letters of recommendation are requested from all applicants.

**TUITION & FEES:**

BGSU has competitive tuition for eCampus students in the program. Please refer to <https://www.bgsu.edu/bursar.html> for current tuition and fees. Not all fees in the tuition brochure apply.

**REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:**

Students request registration through the eCampus office after admission and acceptance to the program. BGSU eCampus students receive one-stop-shop services through the eCampus office, assisting them from application to graduation.

**ACADEMIC CALENDAR:**

Courses are offered in seven-week sessions throughout the year. Students can begin the program in August, October, January, March, May and June.

**DELIVERY MODE:**

The Master of Education in Learning Design program is 100 percent online.

**TEXTBOOK PURCHASE:**

Information is available upon acceptance into the program.

**TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:**

Thirty-six hours are needed to complete the Learning Design program.
