

The Bowling Green State University (BGSU) Master of Science in Criminal Justice (MSCJ) program is a great choice for individuals needing the graduate degree as an entry-level credential for careers in middle management, leadership positions and supervisory roles. The advanced degree is also a coveted asset for those currently working in the field who are seeking advancement and are interested in boosting their professionalism and competence beyond the baccalaureate degree. It takes less than two years to complete the degree if students complete one course every seven weeks.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must have a minimum of a 2.75/4.0 undergraduate grade-point average (GPA) or 3.0 in at least nine credit hours of graduate-level courses. Applicants are required to submit scanned copies of official or unofficial transcripts from all institutions attended. Upon admission, final official or notarized copies of transcripts from all institutions where degrees were earned and diplomas from international institutions must be submitted. The GRE is not required for admission consideration. All applicants must submit a statement outlining their interests in graduate study, plus their expectations and future goals. A resume and two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals with knowledge of the applicant's qualifications and ability to successfully complete graduate study are also required.

TUITION & FEES:

BGSU has competitive tuition for eCampus students in the MSCJ program. Please refer to <https://www.bgsu.edu/bursar.html> for current tuition and fees. Not all fees in the tuition brochure apply.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Students will request registration through the BGSU eCampus office after admission and acceptance to the program. BGSU eCampus students receive one-stop-shop services through the eCampus office, assisting them from application to graduation.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

Courses are offered in seven-week sessions throughout the year. Students can begin the program in August, October, January, March, May and June.

DELIVERY MODE:

Students can complete the MSCJ program 100 percent online part-time. Those that wish to attend full-time have an on-campus option.

TEXTBOOK PURCHASE:

Information is available upon acceptance into the program.

TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

A total of 33 semester credit hours are required to complete the program.

FINANCIAL AID INFO:

Financial Aid is available to eligible students. BGSU eCampus has an assigned financial advisor to assist students with their questions.
