

Welcome to Tech Prep!

In order to receive college credit via Articulation Agreement from LAKELAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE, students must complete the following:

1. The student and high school teacher must sign a form called the Articulation Agreement for the student's program. The form lists the Lakeland class awarded the student because of participation in a high school tech prep program. Forms are posted on this site under Articulation Agreements. The form must be sent to the College Tech Prep office by May 30th.
2. An official, final transcript must be sent to the Tech Prep office by the student's high school no later than August 1st of the graduation year. Submissions of transcripts to Lakeland's admissions office are insufficient.
3. The student must successfully complete an approved high school tech program with a GPA of B (3.0) or higher in the tech prep course work.
4. High schools should mail the signed articulation agreement and transcript to:

5. Students must apply to Lakeland to have credits processed. Students can apply online by clicking on "Apply Now!." Requests for processing of high school tech prep credits must be made within 2 years of high school graduation.
