Happy Friday, everyone!

Today, we're proud to introduce you to the [two newest inductees](#) into the Lakeland Community College Alumni Hall of Fame. Distinguished graduates **Lori Ann Reigert '97** and **Anthony Stachnik, MBA, BSN, RN, CCRN '03** will be honored as the Hall of Fame's class of '24 alongside the class of '25 inductees in a joint ceremony planned for fall 2025, hosted by the [Lakeland Community College Alumni and Friends Network](#).

**Lori Ann Reigert** graduated from Lakeland in 1997 and earned a bachelor's degree in human development and family science from The Ohio State University in 1999. Her great-grandmother, Alta Reigert, was an early member of the Lakeland Community College Board of Trustees and owned The Madison Press. At Ohio State, Lori was inducted to Phi Upsilon Omicron, a national honor society, and received scholarships awarded to students demonstrating outstanding character and service. She made Columbus her home for 20 years.

Lori excelled as a sales and marketing professional, rising to No. 2 nationally in Refreshment Services at Columbus Aramark and winning their 2013 CEO "Circle of Excellence" award. Later, as a trade acceleration manager with ENVISION LLC, she ranked No. 3 regionally in sales volume. Lori was a passionate volunteer, organizing charity drives and participating regularly in cancer prevention fundraisers. She had a strong desire to help others, personally distributing blankets to citizens experiencing homelessness in downtown Columbus and taking an extended work sabbatical to care full-time for a family member in a health crisis. Lori passed away in 2016 at age 40 from Clear Cell Sarcoma and is being inducted posthumously.

**Anthony Stachnik** earned his associate's degree in nursing from Lakeland in 2003, followed by his BSN in 2014 and an MBA in 2023 from Ohio University. He began his career at UH Cleveland Medical Center in 2003 as a critical care bedside nurse in the cardiovascular intensive care unit (CICU) and rapid response team. Currently, Anthony is chief nursing officer at University Hospitals (UH) Lake West Medical Center. He has served in numerous nursing management roles and is a UH Leadership Institute graduate.

Anthony's teams have earned high patient satisfaction scores and multiple awards from the American Association of Critical Care Nurses. The Greater Cleveland Nurses Association has twice recognized him for Faces of Care and as an Aspiring Nurse Leader. Active in his community, Anthony has coached youth baseball since 1994, served as Euclid Boys League Commissioner since 2006, and was named a Citizen of the Year. He also serves on the Windsor-Laurelwood Board of Governors. *(continued)*
